

### TA2 Muscle Car Series set for sizzling season launch under lights at Sydney Motorsport Park



2024 is set to be a big year for the TA2
Muscle Car Series with a brand-new multiyear television deal with SBS Free to Air
Television, Fox Sports Channel 506 and Kayo
Sports. This deal is set for live TV coverage
on both days of each race weekend with a
live stream in the morning on the TA2 Racing
Australia and Hi-Tec Oils Facebook pages.

We are also proud to announce a new partnership with TFH Hire as a co-naming rights partner with HYTEK Framing for all six TA2 Muscle Car rounds. Joshua Thomas will also be joining the series in the TFH Hire Mustang, after sampling TA2 for the first-time last season. Long time motorsport supporters Kubota have also joined our series providing \$1000 cash to the pole winner of every series round.

TA2 also welcomes another rookie to the series, 19-year-old Conner Roberts, former Toyota 86 driver who will drive the #19 Arrow Transport Repairs Dodge Challenger, along with former speedway racer Domain Ramsey.

After a tough 2023 season, South Aussie farm boy Brad Gartner will be driving a brand-new Chevrolet Camaro purchased by Hi-Tec Oils owner George Gambino. The #22 Camaro will have Hi-Tec Oils as the major sponsor and will be serviced and prepared by Ben leads out of PBR Distributions.

2024 frontrunner Josh Haynes will join Waltec Motorsport alongside Kyle Gurton for the 2024 season. Haynes showed a fresh new blue and white livery at the 2024 Winton Launch Day with a new major sponsor Herzog Steel backing Haynes for the season.

Hayden Jackson also rolled out a brand-new look at the 2024 Winton Launch Day with a Gold and Black look for the #81 Dodge Challenger and will be joining the Dream Racing Australia team for the year. South Australian Lee Stibbs, the 2023 Round One winner, has made the switch from MVA Racing to Dream Racing Australia for this season and is expected to be a serious contender for the championship.

The TA2 Muscle cars will be returning to Morgan Park, Queensland Raceway, The Bend Motorsport Park, Winton Motor Raceway and will be heading to One Raceway, what is now the newly rebuilt and rebranded circuit formerly known as Wakefield Park for the first time in October.

2023 Championship winner Dylan Thomas won't be competing in the whole 2024 TA2 series but will carry the #1 at Round 1 in Sydney Motorsport Park in the CXC Racing Mustang.

The inaugural TFH HIRE Formula RX8 race under the lights of Sydney Motorsport Park is set to thrill and entertain in equal measure. The flame spitting 9,000rpm rotaries will be screaming down pit straight, before taking a deep breath and tipping in to the mighty Turn 1 and relying on that legendary RX8 handling and grip to make it through.

TFH HIRE Formula RX8 is a new-for-2024 category that prides itself on being a super close category with tightly policed regulations where the only advantage cars find is with the driver. It's run by a not-for-profit club staffed with volunteers giving something back to the sport they love, so what's not to like?

It's certainly attracted a stunning opening grid of fast and experienced racers from other categories as well as people new to motorsport. TFH HIRE Formula RX8 promises so much to watch up and down the grid.

From Ryan Gorton, a previous one-make RX8 champion, Brad Harris a current TCR race winner, Terry Lewis the 1992 Australian Production Car Champion sporting a replica livery of his famous 'Rainbow Warrior" Mazda RX3, to the 2 car TFH Racing team driven by the fast and versatile Brock Paine and Diesel Thomas. If that wasn't enough there's also the 16 year old Ayrton Filippi fresh from Karting and Formula Vee, and Ivan Vantagiato the e-series ace, facing off with Rob Boaden a previous BMW champion. Series movers Terry Lewis, a race winner himself, will be fast and spectacular in his Yellow Express Machine, and Stacy Vickers a previous 4 time UK champion will provide the international contingent in his BMW Art Car tribute livery.

The cars are beautifully presented, well driven and there's a real community feel down in the pit garages with these guys and girls. Go and say hello. Brap brap, as they say in rotary circles.

## The Australian Super TT Championship kicks of its sophomore season at Sydney Motorsport Park.

Super TT, TT standing for Tin Top, is a category for highly modified vehicles, bridging the gap between Production Cars and a Sports Sedan, while maintaining the original production chassis, and of course roof, hence the name.

Super TT has been a popular state-based category, catering for wide variety of vehicles compete in over and under 2 litre classes from Nissans & BMWs powered by V8s, Turbo Charged vehicles like Falcons and 4-wheel drive Mitsubishis & Subarus, Lotuses, Hondas, Mazdas, rapid Nissan Pulsars and even Brute Utes!

Races within races will occur in Super TT with Class Battles between the "Big Banger" over 2 Litre Slicks Cars, the more Production Based Over 2 Litre Treaded and the Pocket Rocket under 2 Litre.

In fact, the reigning National Champion is one of those Pocket Rockets, Michael Ricketts, who cleaned up the big cars with is consistency in his Young Car Wash sponsored Nissan Pulsar in 2023. Rickets will be back to defend the title and head the Under 2 Litre brigade.

Outright and Over 2litre Slicks honours promise to be a re-match from the 2023 Sydney Motorsport Round with Cory Gillet in the V8 Nissan Silva battling 2023 Victorian Champion and Australian Series Runner-up Brent Edwards in the BA Turbo Falcon. Corey got the upper hand last time in Sydney, while Brent took out the damp final 2023 round at Calder Park.

3rd in the 2023 Series was the first of the Over 2 Litre Treaded Class car wit Ryan Bell in the Nissan 370Z. Ryan returns to Sydney where in the corresponding round last year, he took the bottom step of the podium for 3rd outright.

The Championship Visits 4 states in 2024 starting with Round 1 Sydney Motorsport Park (April 19 – 20) Then heads to Queensland Raceway for Round 2 (June 29 – 30), The Bend in South Australia hosts Round 3 (August 30 – September 1) with the 4th final round and Country Victoria's Winton Raceway (October 5-6).

## A New Year, A New Category



The Hi-Tec Oils Super Series is excited to welcome a new race category to the programme, Hi-Tec Drifting Australia (HTDA). HTDA will join the Hi-Tec Oil Super Series for four rounds during 2024, kicking off at this week's Sydney Motorsport Park.

With the inclusion of HTDA into the programme, it is anticipated that having a mixture of drifting and circuit racing will attract fans across all generations to attend events, tune into the live stream and watch the television coverage.

Drifting is now one of the fastest growing subdisciplines within motorsport, mainly due to the popularity of the movie franchise "The Fast and the Furious". It's the smoking tyres and mind-bending driving techniques which is captivating audiences world-wide.

HTDA is celebrating its ten year anniversary in 2024. The 'drift scene' in Australia has been around since the early 2000s however it wasn't until Hi-Tec Oils founder and CEO, George Gambino saw an opportunity for a premier, national drift competition, that HTDA was born.

This year's HTDA All Stars drift competition will see Pro Am drivers battle it out over six rounds for the ultimate drift prize.

#### DRIFTING - A BRIEF OVERVIEW

Drifting is a sport that focuses on a specific 'drifting' driving technique, which has been used in other motorsports, such as rally and speedway racing. Drifters use the throttle, brakes, clutch, gear shifting and steering to keep the car in a state of oversteer to drive sideways into corners, all the while maintaining full control of the car.

Unlike circuit racing where the tracks are several kilometres long, the distances for drift tracks are much shorter. Typically only a few hundred meters long, the drift race track consists of as many curves and corners as possible. The straight sections in between allow the cars to pick up speed in order to slide through the upcoming corners at the highest possible speed and with a high drift angle.

It also isn't the traditional motorsport where lap times or placement on track plays a role in a team's overall score.

While each race and event is different, there are four key criteria that HTDA's three judges consider during a race:

- Speed & fluidity
- Drift Angle
- The Line
- Style

During qualifications, the drivers perform solo drift runs. After each run, the judges give the driver a score. Usually each driver has three runs, the first being a warm-up one, the second and the third run are the good 'runs'.

After qualifying, the judges set up a tennis tournament style bracket, in which the best driver is going to race against the worst driver, the second best vs the second worst etc. This phase is called twin drift, battle or tsuiso in Japanese.

During battles the drivers confront each other, one leading and the other chasing in the first run. The starting order is reversed during the second run. The driver who gets the best score of the two runs advances to the next stage\*
